

1 **SEC. _____ . REPORT ON ARMY LIVE-FIRE RANGES IN HA-**
2 **WAIL.**

3 Not later than March 1, 2007, the Secretary of the
4 Army shall submit to Congress a report on the adequacy
5 of the live-fire ranges of the Army in the State of Hawaii
6 with respect to current and future training requirements.
7 The report shall include the following:

8 (1) An evaluation of the capacity of the existing
9 live-fire ranges to meet the training requirements of
10 the Army, including the training requirements of
11 Stryker Brigade Combat Teams.

12 (2) A description of any existing plan to modify
13 or expand any range in Hawaii for the purpose of
14 meeting anticipated live-fire training requirements.

15 (3) A description of the current live-fire restric-
16 tions at the Makua Valley range and the effect of
17 these restrictions on unit readiness.

18 (4) Cost and schedule estimates for the con-
19 struction of new ranges or the modification of exist-
20 ing ranges that are necessary to support future
21 training requirements if existing restrictions on
22 training at the Makua Valley range remain in place.
