Alexander, Vitter Announce USDA Funding for Delta Wastewater Treatment Plant

(Washington, D.C.) – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander and U.S. Sen. David Vitter announced today that the Village of Delta will receive a United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Development grant totaling \$95,527 for the construction of a new wastewater treatment plant.

The funding will be used to replace the existing sewer treatment plant, which is not compliant with the Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals and Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality discharge limits.

“Improving the sewer system is vital for the health and well-being of the residents of Delta as well as for the health of the environment, which is particularly important in an area so close to the Mississippi River,” Alexander said. “I am pleased that Delta has received the funding it needs to begin this project.”

“I am pleased the USDA Rural Development made this funding available to Delta,” Vitter said. “These residents need an up-to-date wastewater treatment plant, and this funding will help them acquire this.”
