

Alexander Appoints Long-Time Staffer to Serve as State Director

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, today announced that Jonathan Johnson will serve as State Director to oversee operations in Alexander’s 5th Congressional District offices in Monroe and Alexandria.

Johnson, a native of Choudrant, La., first joined Alexander’s staff as a field representative in December 2002 after Alexander was elected to Congress for his first term. In August 2004, Johnson relocated to Washington, D.C., where he served as the Congressman’s scheduler until December 2005 when he returned to the 5th District to serve as Special Assistant.

“For the past several years, Jonathan has proven himself to be a hard-working, dedicated member of my staff,” Alexander said.

“Jonathan understands the needs of the 5th District and is eager to see those needs addressed. I am very confident in his abilities to serve the district well in this role.”

Johnson said he is looking forward to beginning his new assignment.

Johnson will also be coordinating the District offices’ operations with Adam Terry, who has been named Administrative Assistant and will oversee legislative operations and handle managerial responsibilities in Alexander’s Washington, D.C. office.
