Alexander Announces Federal Funding for Monroe Housing Authority

WASHINGTON, D.C. – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander, R-Quitman, today announced that the Monroe Housing Authority will receive a grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development totaling \$3,116,700 to construct 36 one-bedroom units at the South Pointe Retirement Community in Monroe.

The units will be built in nine single-story buildings in areas with easy access to grocery and retail shopping as well as public transportation. The site is also located across from a park and newly constructed recreation/senior center.

“With so many seniors enjoying active lifestyles these days, there is a need for housing facilities such as these to ensure that senior citizens can maintain their independence,” Alexander said. **“I want to thank the Monroe Housing Authority for working to improve the quality of life for seniors in the area.”**
