Alexander, Vitter Announce Grant Funding for East Carroll

(Washington D.C.) – U.S. Rep. Rodney Alexander and U.S. Sen. David Vitter announced today that the East Carroll Law Enforcement District will receive a USDA Community Facilities Grant totaling \$25,674 for the purchase of two new police cars and equipment.

“As the men and women serving in the East Carroll police unit work to keep order and protect the residents of the parish, having up-to-date, reliable equipment is an important factor of their jobs,” Alexander said. “Fortunately, with this funding from the USDA, the East Carroll Law Enforcement District will be able to obtain the equipment they need.”

“It is especially critical in rural areas that law enforcement officials have safe and reliable vehicles,” Vitter said. “These USDA funds will help local officers as they work to protect our communities along the Mississippi Delta.”
