SUSPENSION CALENDAR

- 1) ***Honoring the Contributions of Catholic Schools*** (H.Res. 23). 
This resolution has no budget implications.
- 2) ***To Designate the Facility of the United States Postal Service Located at 30777 Rancho California Road in Temecula, California, as the "Dalip Singh Saund Post Office Building"*** (H.R. 120). 
This bill neither increases direct spending nor reduces revenue.
- 3) ***To Designate the Facility of the United States Postal Service Located at 8200 South Vermont Avenue in Los Angeles, California, as the "Staff Sergeant First Class John Marshall Post Office Building"*** (H.R. 289). 
This bill neither increases direct spending nor reduces revenue.
- 4) ***Commending the Palestinian People for Holding Recent Elections.*** 
This resolution has no budget implications.
- 5) ***Expressing the Strong Concern of the House of Representatives That the European Union May End Its Embargo Against the People's Republic of China.*** 
This resolution has no budget implications.

LEGISLATION CONSIDERED UNDER A RULE

- Resolution:** ***Expressing the Continued Support of Congress for Equal Access of Military Recruiters to Institutions of Higher Education.***
- Committee:** Armed Services
- Summary:** This concurrent resolution expresses the continued support of Congress for access of military recruiters to college and university students and campuses that is equal in quality and scope to that provided all other employers.
- Cost:** The Congressional Budget Office [CBO] has not provided a cost estimate for this resolution, but the measure is not expected to affect direct spending or revenue.
- Budget Act:** The bill is not expected to violate any provisions of the Congressional Budget Act.
