Written Application

Please enclose a resume, writing sample, and two letters of recommendation with your completed application. Please type or print legibly. If internships are available, interviews will be arranged in either our Washington office or through one of the district offices upon receipt of your completed application. **Spring applicants should apply no later than October 1st, Summer applicants should apply no later than February 1st, and Fall applicants should apply no later than May 1st.**

Notification and Housing

Following the application process, interns selected will be notified of the dates that they are to report to Congressman Deal's Washington, DC office. Congressional offices are prohibited from making arrangements or recommendations for specific housing locations; however, our office is able to provide each selected intern with an informational packet about housing in the Washington, DC area. A living stipend is available.
