Dingell asks Comcast to reconsider changes

U.S. Rep. John D. Dingell, D-Dearborn, on Friday announced he's submitted a letter to the CEO of the Comcast Corp. challenging a decision requiring customers to lease additional equipment from the company to view public, education and governmental channels. Dingell, chairman of the Committee on Energy and Commerce, urged the company to reconsider a decision that would place most public access channels into the 900s starting Jan. 15 and force subscribers to rent an extra box for \$4 a month to view them.
