Entry Guidelines

The competition is open to high school students only and limited to one entry per student. In order to allow a work of art to hang in the Cannon Tunnel of the U.S. Capitol, the following restrictions are necessary:

- o The entry must be two dimensional and no larger than 32" X 32"
- o Artwork cannot be more than 4" deep
- o Artwork categories are as follows:
 - Paintings (oil, acrylics, watercolor, etc.)
 - Drawings (pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, markers, etc.)
 - Collage (must be two dimensional)
 - Prints (lithographs, silkscreen, block prints)
 - Mixed Media
 - Computer generated art
 - Photography

NOTE: Any entry reproduced from an existing photo, painting or any other work produced by another person is a violation of the competition rules and WILL NOT be accepted!

Suitability Guidelines

All entries will be reviewed by a panel of judges and winners will be notified. *Artwork must adhere to the policy of the House Office Building Commission. In accordance with his policy, exhibits depicting subjects of contemporary political controversy or of a sensationalistic or gruesome nature are not allowed.*
