**Representative Frank and Senator Kennedy Announce
Department of Education Grant**

Congressman Barney Frank and Senator Edward Kennedy today announced the award of a Department of Education *Carol M. White Physical Education Grant* for the amount of \$79,089 to Norfolk County Agricultural High School. Funding will be used to implement Healthy Choices, an initiative to enhance the high school's physical fitness and nutrition education programs.

According to Angela L. Avery, Superintendent of Norfolk County Agricultural High School, "The Healthy Choices Grant will allow the school to strengthen the Physical Education and Fitness Program by updating curriculum and provide after school recreational activities. A new fitness center and trained professional staff will be available to students and staff. We are very excited to have this opportunity to create a model health and wellness program".

Congressman Frank said, "With increased public awareness of the importance of physical fitness and nutrition to our nation's health, this grant is especially relevant. I know Norfolk County Agricultural High School will put it to good use".

Senator Kennedy said, "These funds will enable Norfolk County Agricultural High School to provide its students with more opportunities that emphasize the importance of physical education. The benefit to the students will be lifelong, and I commend the high school for its leadership in encouraging them to stay active and live healthy lives".
