Recently released by the Defense Department, the National Military Strategic Plan for the War on Terrorism emphasizes our need to "keep the world's most dangerous weapons out of the hands of the world's most dangerous people."

This need is vital. Currently, Iranian extremists headed by Iranian "president" Mahmoud Ahmadinejad are moving closer towards possessing nuclear weapons. Upon obtaining such capabilities, there is no telling what actions this fanatical regime might take. A nuclear-weapons capable Iran would represent one of the gravest threats to face the United States and its allies.

The DOD report sets out a clear strategy regarding terrorism: "We must deny them what they need to operate."

The Iran Freedom Support Act (H.R. 282 - IFSA) is in keeping with the DOD's strategy. H.R. 282 seeks to deny the Iranian regime critical financial resources to pursue unconventional weapons programs, incite terror, and oppress the Iranian people.

It is time for the Congress to set the agenda and actuate our strategy to deny these dangerous extremists all that they need to carry out their sadistic objectives.






