Hensarling Calls on Congress to Control Spending

WASHINGTON – Today, Congressman Jeb Hensarling (R-TX) issued the following statement regarding the delivery of President Bush’s Fiscal Year 2006 budget to Congress:

“The first step toward saving Social Security is to get the government’s fiscal house in order. I believe President Bush has outlined the right set of priorities for a nation facing enormous fiscal challenges while fighting a global War on Terror.

“I hope Congress will improve on the President’s budget, to enforce more fiscal responsibility and ensure greater accountability to American taxpayers.
