MYRICK CALLS ON THE AMERICAN PEOPLE: “LET YOUR VOICE BE HEARD!”

(Washington, DC) – US Representative Sue Myrick (NC-09) has one request of the American people: “Let your voice be heard!”

“What has happened in Congress over the past few days has never happened before,” said Rep. Myrick. “I’m outraged at how the actions of one person have silenced the voice of the American people. We’re only asking the Majority for one thing, and that’s for us to be able to vote on the legislation that will start to address our energy needs. The Majority made this promise when they took office, and that promise has been broken.”

“The Speaker of the House and all other members of Congress don’t just represent their own districts – we’re here to represent the American people. Call the Speaker. Call all Members of Congress. Let them know that you want a vote on energy.”

Despite the adjournment, Republicans remain on the House Floor to talk to the citizens who continue to visit the House Chamber.
