## **Prevention of Unsafe Licensing Act** **Be an Original Cosponsor**

Dear Colleague:

The ability of illegal aliens to obtain state-issued driver's licenses is a national security risk with dire consequences. Yet, some states are choosing to issue licenses to illegal aliens by exploiting a loophole in the law. The "Prevention of Unsafe Licensing Act" will close this loophole.

The "Prevention of Unsafe Licensing Act" prohibits states from issuing any driver's license or identification card to an individual unlawfully present in the U.S. The American people know that an illegal alien, who has already broken our federal laws, should not be rewarded with a state-issued driver's license – an ID which could be used to open bank accounts, rent cars and apartments, purchase firearms, and commit voter fraud. These driver's licenses may also make it more difficult for employers to check the legal status for work authorization of their employees.

The federal government has the obligation to deal with illegal immigration and protect the homeland. Please join us in preventing states from issuing these licenses and threatening our national security.
