## ***Kilpatrick: Response To The Capture of Saddam Hussein***

Congresswoman Carolyn Cheeks Kilpatrick (13<sup>th</sup> District, MI), says the capture of former Iraqi dictator Saddam Hussein is good news for the Iraqi people. "Saddam Hussein should face a trial established by the Iraqi governing authorities and face charges on the human rights allegations raised against him," said Congresswoman Kilpatrick.

It appears that we still face significant challenges in Iraq. The same day of the announcement of Hussein's capture, there were two suicide bombers who killed several members of the Iraqi police.
