1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Consumer and Pro-  
5 ducer Protection Act of 2004”.



1 **SEC. 2. PREVENTION OF SLAUGHTER FOR HUMAN CON-**  
2 **SUMPTION OF CERTAIN CATTLE.**

3 (a) NON-AMBULATORY DEFINED.—Section 1 of the  
4 Federal Meat Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. 601) is amended  
5 by adding at the end the following new subsection:

6 “(w) The term ‘non-ambulatory’ shall apply to any  
7 cattle that, at the time of examination and inspection  
8 under section 3(a), is unable to rise from a recumbent po-  
9 sition or unable to walk for any reason, including meta-  
10 bolic conditions or central nervous system disorders, un-  
11 less the reason for such inability is fatigue, stress,  
12 obdurator nerve paralysis, obesity, or one or more broken  
13 or fractured appendages, severed tendons or ligaments, or  
14 dislocated joints.”.

15 (b) PROHIBITION ON ALLOWING CERTAIN CATTLE  
16 TO PASS INSPECTION.—Section 3(a) of the Federal Meat  
17 Inspection Act (21 U.S.C. 603(a)) is amended by adding  
18 at the end the following new sentence: “All cattle found  
19 on such inspection to be non-ambulatory, to test positive  
20 for central nervous system disorders, to exhibit signs of  
21 bovine spongiform encephalopathy (including moribund  
22 condition, tetanus, or emaciation), or to be dead prior to  
23 examination and inspection shall be found to be adulter-  
24 ated for purposes of section 4.”.
