Over 2 million People Enter the U.S. Illegally Every Year!

The time for meaningful action on Border Security is now.



In a post 9/11 world, protecting our borders has taken on a whole new urgency. We cannot separate the issue of border security and homeland security. In order to successfully fight the War on Terror, we must protect our borders and points of entry.

There are people entering our country who are seeking economic opportunities and those who wish do us harm. Accordingly, criminal terrorists must be barred from entering the country, while those seeking economic opportunities should be met with a different strategy.

As a member of the House Committee on Homeland Security that has jurisdiction over border matters, and Chairman of the Subcommittee on Investigations, I have been a strong voice for border security, and you can be certain that I will fight to ensure that our borders are more secure and America is safer as a result.

Congressman McCaul has already supported:

- **Homeland Security Volunteerism Enhancement Act** enables law abiding citizens to assist U.S. Border Patrol in defending our nations borders after undergoing federal training. **Authored**
- **Introduced legislation** that ends the current "catch and release" policy by detaining all special interest aliens apprehended at the border, and authorizes the Secretary of Homeland Security to create temporary detention space areas to house those apprehended.
- **Authored a letter** signed by 45 representatives asking the Appropriations Committee for 2,000 border patrol agents and 8,000 detention beds.
- **Signed a letter** to the President asking to declare a state of emergency along the Texas - Mexico border, and return the border patrol agents from Arizona to Texas.
- **H.R. 418, the Real ID Act** implements much needed driver's license reforms, closes asylum loopholes, enhances border security and strengthens deportation laws. **Signed into Law**
- **H.R. 1817, The Homeland Security Authorization Act** provides for funding to heighten border security and port enforcement with the recruiting and training of 2,000 new border agents, streamlines counter-terrorism and intelligence-gathering efforts, increases analytic expertise and improves readiness through training exercises. In addition, an amendment I offered, which passed the House, authorizes additional funds for training of local law enforcement to help enforce federal immigration laws. **Passed by the House**
- **House Concurrent Resolution 50** strongly expresses disapproval of the current totalization agreement with Mexico that gives benefits to illegal immigrants, undermines our Social Security system and rewards illegal behavior. **Cosponsor**
