Shuster Secures \$125,000 for the Army Heritage and Education Center in Cumberland County

Washington, D.C. –**Congressman Bill Shuster** is pleased to announce that he successfully secured \$125,000 in the Omnibus Appropriations Act to fund a project for the Military Heritage and Education Center in Cumberland County.

The \$125,000 will be used to enhance educational opportunities at the Army Heritage and Education Center in Cumberland County for college students majoring in history and education. Specifically, the funding will enable students to work with the Heritage Center to create and develop educational materials for visitors to the Center.

“The Army Heritage and Education Center enriches visitors with the long and proud history of the United States Army,” Shuster said. “This project will enable college students to help build on the educational programs already available at the Center, improving visitors’ experiences as well as improving the student’s academic background.”
