Shuster Secures \$250,000 for the New Fulton County Medical Center

Washington, D.C. –**Congressman Bill Shuster** is pleased to announce that he successfully secured \$250,000 in the Omnibus Appropriations Act for the new Fulton County Medical Center. The \$250,000 will be used for construction costs and for the purchase of new equipment.

“I have been impressed by the staff of the Fulton County Medical Center throughout its work to complete their new facility,” Shuster said. “From signing the commemorative beam at the beginning of the project, to touring it while under construction, I have been following the center’s development closely.”

Congressman Shuster played a key role in securing a \$756,000 HERSA grant for the planning of the new facility. Shuster also toured the medical center on August 14th while it was still under construction. Now that the state-of-the-art facility is open, Shuster is interested in making sure the medical center gets the equipment and support they need to continue their long history of care to the community.

“It is my hope that the funding secured in the Omnibus for the Fulton County Medical Center will help complete their acquisition of brand new medical technologies and cover outstanding constructions costs,” Shuster added. “They’ve always done great work and they deserve our continuing support.”
