Shuster Secures \$98,000 to Improve Martinsburg Borough's Infrastructure

Washington, D.C. –**Congressman Bill Shuster** is pleased to announce that he successfully secured \$98,000 in the Omnibus Appropriations Act for the Martinsburg Borough's Streetscape Project. The Omnibus was passed by the House last night and will be signed into law by the President in a matter of days.

“This funding will go to directly improve economic development in Blair County, something that is a top priority of my legislative agenda,” Shuster added. “I am pleased to have secured this project in the Omnibus bill.”

The \$98,000 will be used to make critical upgrades to the infrastructure in the business district of the Borough of Martinsburg in Blair County. Specifically, the funding will be used for the relocation of a utility pole, crosswalk enhancements and storm water inlets.

“Successful economic development is directly linked to the quality of the infrastructure that must support it,” Shuster said. “Improvements like this will draw new business into the area and help promote those already established in the Borough of Martinsburg.”
