Disaster Loan Application Deadline Nears

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that a deadline is approaching for obtaining disaster loans from the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA). The SBA is reviewing loan applications related to recent losses from tornadoes and flooding in eleven South Carolina counties, including Sumter and Florence.

The filing deadline for physical loss is December 20 and the deadline for economic injury is July 21. Disaster victims interested in applying to the SBA for physical loss loans are urged to do so immediately.

SBA staff is available to hand out and help with disaster loan applications at the Clarendon County Department of Social Services Bldg., 3 South Church Street, Manning, SC, from 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., Monday-Friday. Application forms are not available over the Internet.
