Spratt Announces Grant for Thicketty Creek Bridge

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that the Federal Highway Administration has granted \$405,000 for the use of high performance steel in the Thicketty Creek bridge replacement project.

“High performance steel resists corrosion and fatigue and saves money in repair costs over the long run,” said Spratt. “I am pleased the project is receiving funding for this material.”

The Thicketty Creek bridge on U.S. 29 in Cherokee County was built in 1938. The total replacement cost is estimated to be \$2.8 million.
