Spratt Announces \$1.1 Million Grant for Fort Mill Housing Services, Inc.

HUD funds will be used to build 14 apartments in Rock Hill for persons with disabilities

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that Fort Mill Housing Services, Inc. has been awarded a \$1.1 million federal grant to build 14 apartments in Rock Hill for persons with disabilities.

The project, funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), will be located on Mont Holly Road and consist of seven duplex buildings, each with two one-bedroom apartments. The units will be about 540 square feet in size. All but one will be accessible to persons with physical impairments, and one will be designed for the hearing impaired. In addition, a 1,000 square-foot community center is planned, containing a meeting room, restroom, warming kitchen, and laundry.

“This grant,” said Spratt, “will help persons with disabilities to live as independently as possible in the community. I am delighted that Fort Mill Housing Services won the funding.”
