## **Spratt Announces \$1 Million Grant for York**

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that the City of York has been awarded a \$1 million federal grant to help fund a plan to bring water from Lake Wylie to the city.

The grant, from the Economic Development Administration (EDA), would go toward construction of 13 miles of water main from a new Lake Wylie water treatment plant.

“EDA has come through for York once again,” said Spratt. “These funds will supplement the \$1 million dollar earmark appropriated in the Housing and Urban Development budget a year ago, and help York enlarge and improve its water system. York cannot finance these improvements solely on its own or from users through fees. I hope this federal money will help York do what it cannot do by itself and make a new water system feasible.”

Spratt said EDA helps plan and implement economic development projects in communities nationwide, working with state and local governments, regional economic development districts, non-profit organizations, and Indian tribes.
