### Spratt Announces Grants for S.C. Communities

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) today announced the following grants for communities in South Carolina. The grants are from the U.S. Department of Agriculture’s Rural Development Service.

“USDA grants are a big help to cities and towns all over South Carolina,” Spratt said.

County	Recipient	Grant Award	Description
Chesterfield	Town of Cheraw	\$32,000	Housing Preservation Grant. The funds will be used to improve housing for up to 12 very-low-income homeowners in Cheraw. The town is contributing \$6,400.
Chesterfield	Alligator Rural Water and Sewer Company, Inc.	\$212,900	Water and Waste Disposal Grant. The funds will be used to cover cost overruns incurred with a project to provide water to the towns of Chesterfield and Pageland. The project, which also serves users in surrounding areas of Chesterfield County, involves 78,000 feet of line, 3 wells, and generators for new and existing wells. A total of 1,370 residential users and 7 commercial users will benefit from the project.
Marlboro	City of Bennettsville	\$16,250	Housing Preservation Grant. The funds will be used to provide repair services for four low-income, elderly homeowners in Bennettsville. The city will contribute \$16,250.
