Goucher White Plains Vol. Fire Department Awarded Grant

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that Goucher White Plains Volunteer Fire Department, of Gaffney, has been awarded a grant from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.
