Spratt Announces Grant for Fort Mill

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that Fort Mill has been awarded a \$175,000 grant from the National Park Service for a new recreation complex at Doby's Bridge Road Park. The money will help to fund a youth baseball field, playground, landscaping, and support facilities.

The grant is part of the "Land and Water Conservation Fund" program, which provides matching grants to state and local governments, helping them to acquire, develop, improve, and maintain high quality outdoor recreation areas.

The total cost of the Doby's Bridge project is \$350,000.
