Spratt Announces Loan and Grant for Alligator

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that Alligator Rural Water and Sewer Company, of McBee, has won approval of a \$2 million loan and a \$1.3 million grant from the federal government.

Spratt said the funds, from the U.S. Department of Agriculture, will be used to build a new booster pump station, an office, and a new treatment facility.

“This is great news,” said Spratt. “A top quality water system makes it easier for the community to attract industry and jobs.”

Spratt said the funds will also be used to buy construction equipment and install water lines. The lines will serve lower Chesterfield County and will allow Cassatt Rural Water Company to tie into Alligator’s water supply. Cassatt will purchase at least 3 million gallons of water per month.

The project will benefit 1,370 residential customers.
