### **Spratt Announces Water/Sewer Funds for Chesterfield and McBee**

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that the towns of Chesterfield and McBee have been awarded water/sewer loans and grants from the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

Chesterfield is getting a \$205,900 loan and a \$617,000 grant. The money will be used to bring its facilities in compliance with new state regulations, in particular, correcting unacceptable levels of oxygen and ammonia in the system.

McBee will receive a \$172,200 loan and a \$519,000 grant. The money will be used to complete the removal of unacceptable levels of asbestos in the water system.

“These loans and grants,” said Spratt, “are good examples of how the federal government helps small towns and communities.”
