Federal Aid to Help Communities Recover from Ice Storm
Briefing for Applicants Scheduled for Friday, January 17, in York

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) says federal funds will be available to help Cherokee and York counties recover from the severe ice storm that hit the area December 4-6, 2002.

On Friday, January 17, the State of South Carolina and the Federal Emergency Management Agency will conduct a briefing in York for eligible applicants, which include local governments, private nonprofit organizations, and Native American tribes.

The briefing is scheduled for 10:00 a.m. in the York County Council Chambers, next door to the Courthouse, 6 South Congress Street, in York.
