Spratt Announces Award for Marlboro School District

WASHINGTON – U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) announced today that Marlboro County School District has received a \$77,976 award from the Universal Service Administrative Company for telecommunications support.

The Universal Service program, established by the Telecommunications Act of 1996, enables public schools and libraries to have state-of-the-art telecommunications equipment for their students. It is funded through the universal service fee on monthly phone bills and goes toward telecommunications services and Internet access.

“I am pleased to see that the universal service fee comes back to us in the form of good telecommunications equipment for our school children,” said Spratt.

Earlier this year, the county school district received \$24, 480 and Bennettsville High School received \$28,700 from the program.
