Spratt Gets Postal Address for Indian Land

WASHINGTON — Residents of the Indian Land community in Lancaster County can now use “Indian Land, South Carolina 29715” as their address instead of using Fort Mill, thanks to an inquiry with the Postal Service from U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC).

“I was delighted to learn the Postal Service has added Indian Land as a valid mailing name for zip code 29715,” said Spratt. “This designation helps to give the citizens of Indian Land a sense of community that they have long deserved.”

Spratt said he initially contacted the Postal Service on behalf of an Indian Land resident who asked about getting a separate post office for the community.

“The Postal Service’s mid-Carolina manager in Charlotte explained that while the Postal Service could not offer the community a post office of its own at this time, they could provide a valid mailing name,” Spratt said.

“It’s good news. It not only helps build community pride,” said Spratt, “it clears up the confusion that arose when Indian Land citizens, who live in Lancaster County, had to use Fort Mill as their address, which is in York County. While I’d personally like to see every community have its own post office, I think this result is something we can cheer about.”
