Spratt Releases List of 228 Citizens Owed Refunds by the IRS

ROCK HILL, S.C. — U.S. Rep. John Spratt (D-SC) today released the names of 228 citizens in the 5th Congressional District of South Carolina who are owed refunds by the IRS.

The refunds, which are undeliverable or unclaimed, total \$105,541.90 for a ten-year period covering tax years 1988-1998. The largest refund owed to a taxpayer in the 5th District for the period comes to \$6,268.

Spratt said the IRS owes refunds to citizens in each of the 13 counties in the 5th District: Cherokee, Chester, Chesterfield, Darlington, Dillon, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lancaster, Lee, Marlboro, Newberry, Sumter, and York.

Spratt released the list of names, which he obtained from the IRS, at a news conference today in Rock Hill. He also posted the list on his congressional office web site, **www.house.gov/spratt (news releases section)**. The site also includes a news release from Spratt on the topic, a fact sheet, and information on how to obtain a refund.

“Some of these refunds are unclaimed. Some are undeliverable. In any event, they are collecting dust at the IRS,” said Spratt. “I am hopeful that release of this list will help people in my district get the refunds they are owed.”
