Dear Chairmen and Ranking Members:

We write to respectfully request you support the President's recommendation of \$85 million for the State Extended Care Facilities Grant Program in the Fiscal Year 2007 Military Quality of Life and Veterans Affairs Appropriations Act. This program provides funds to construct and maintain extended care facilities through a 65 percent to 35 percent federal-state match. While the President's FY 2007 request of \$85 million would maintain the amount appropriated in the previous fiscal year, we would encourage any additional amounts to enable California to accelerate work on these projects. We also request that the grants be available for both the construction of new homes and for improvements to existing extended care facilities.

Our home state of California has more than 2.3 million residents who are veterans. Many of the men and women who served our country in uniform now unfortunately find themselves in need of basic healthcare and housing. For those with limited options available, veterans' homes provide a critical safety net for their well-being.

In California, veterans are forced to endure a two-year waiting list to join one of the state's three veterans' homes in Yountville, Chula Vista, and Barstow. Unfortunately, in many cases, eligible veterans pass away before they are ever admitted. The United States Department of Veterans Affairs reports that California has the greatest need for additional veterans' homes and the state is committed to working with the federal government to build new facilities. Plans for five new facilities are now underway in Los Angeles, Lancaster, Ventura County, Fresno, and Redding.

Any reduction to the State Extended Care Facilities Grant Program or restriction on the use of funds for new projects would delay the construction of these new California veterans' homes and jeopardize construction and maintenance of homes in other states. Clearly, the well-being of our veterans is at stake.

Thank you for your consideration and support for this program. As Americans, we have all counted on veterans in the past, and we should never forget the contributions they have made to our country. Now, our veterans are counting on you.


