Dear Congressmen:



(NARVRE) is greatly concerned and excited about the above captioned legislation, which we understand is presently being considered for introduction in the Congress. We are informed similar legislation was introduced in the 108th Congress and was identified as H. R. 4357.

We understand the Medicare buy in will benefit persons between 55 and 65 years of age. Also the legislation will include a refundable, advanceable tax credit for 75% of the cost of coverage (pay only 25%). Also we understand Medicare buy in is available to those with employer provided benefits; early retiree can buy in with employer wrap.

Members of NARVRE will be greatly affected by such legislation and we are proud to join with other groups who no doubt will support this effort. Therefore please consider NARVRE and its membership across the country as a strong supporter of the legislation. We will await further information as the legislation is developed.
