FHA Refinancing: Members voted, 256-171, to repeal the six-months-old FHA Refinance Program, which is designed to help underwater homeowners who are current on payments keep their homes. A yes vote was to pass HR 830 on grounds the program has helped only 40 or so households.

Jobless Homeowners: Members voted, 242-177, to repeal the Emergency Mortgage Relief Program, which is designed to help those who have lost their jobs keep their homes, but which critics say has been a potentially costly failure since it was enacted last year. A yes vote was to pass HR 836.
